### Career

- In 2004, became a Rolex First-Time Winner at the Giant Eagle LPGA Classic; tied for seventh at the U.S. Women's Open for her career-best finish in a major championship.
- In 2003, best finish was a tie for ninth at the Wegmans Rochester LPGA, where she recorded her second LPGA career hole-in-one during the first round; crossed the \$1 million mark in career earnings with a tie for 33<sup>rd</sup> at the Kraft Nabisco Championship.
- In 2002, recorded her season-best finish at the Williams Championship, where she tied for seventh.
- In 2001, tied for second at both the First Union Betsy King Classic and the Wendy's Championship for Children at New Albany, where she posted a career-low 64 during the second round.
- In 2000, best finish was a tie for third at the Philips Invitational Honoring Harvey Penick.
- In 1999, best finish was a tie for second at the Sunrise Hawaiian Ladies Open.
- In 1998, best finish was a tie for fourth at the Wegmans Rochester International.
- In 1997, tied for eighth at the Giant Eagle LPGA Classic for her best finish of the season.
- In 1996, top finish was a tie for 23<sup>rd</sup> at the Safeway LPGA Golf Championship.
- In 1995, recorded her first LPGA career hole-in-one during the first round of the Friendly's Classic; posted her season-best finish, a tie for sixth, at the SAFECO Classic.
- In 1994, turned professional in August; qualified for the Tour at the LPGA Final Qualifying Tournament, where she tied for 20<sup>th</sup> to earn exempt status for the 1995 season.

## Amateur

Dunn won titles at the 1989 New York State Junior Girls Championship, the 1992-94 New York State Women's Amateur Championships and the 1992 Women's Western Amateur Championship. In addition, she was runner-up at the 1993 Doherty Championship. She was named a Second-Team All-American from 1993-94 while a member of the Florida International University golf team and was a 1993 Academic All-American.
